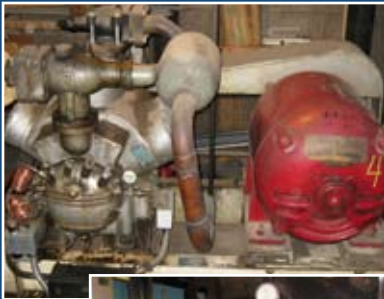

Ohio's first and longest running television station is WEWS in Cleveland. Their current facility was built in 1956. Many of the mechanical systems installed then are still operating today thanks to the Brewer-Garrett Assured Service Program.
